On behalf of the All Saints Catholic School staff, welcome to the 2026-27 school year! We are so excited for the upcoming year!

Please help us welcome new staff members to All Saints! We are blessed and thankful to introduce Kara Benkis (6th grade homeroom) and Emilee Hercules (7th grade homeroom). With these new additions, there will be some changes to other instructional responsibilities. We ask that you guide and support your child's learning by:

1. Attend school daily and arrive on time, ready for the day's learning experience.
2. Complete all homework assignments given by teachers; all students will be provided a planner for daily communication - please check it.
3. Read daily to develop a love for reading and to improve literacy skills.

Consider joining our school volunteer program; students benefit greatly from your involvement and contributions to the school's program and operations. For every hour volunteered, \$15 will be deducted from your tuition. We seek volunteers to help us with the following activities: 1) Practicing math facts with students who need extra help, 2) Reading with students who need extra help, 3) cleaning, 4) uniform organizing, 5) coaching, and 6) school-wide events.

We begin our year with a meet and greet the morning of August 10 from 7:45-8:30 am. This is also a great time to meet classroom teachers, drop off school supplies, and bring medications to be left in the office for the school year. August 10-12 are early dismissal at 1:30; lunch will be served.

For those of you who drop off/pick up your student(s), please remember that there is **no double parking on 10th Street**. Please remember, it is not safe for students to cross 10th Street, except at the traffic light. We will not allow students to walk across the middle of the street (jaywalking); they must go to the traffic light, wait for the walking signal, and then cross. It is safer to pick your student up in the back parking lot, rather than double park on 10th Street.

Please bring back uniforms that your students have outgrown. There will be a used uniform sale throughout the first week of school.
