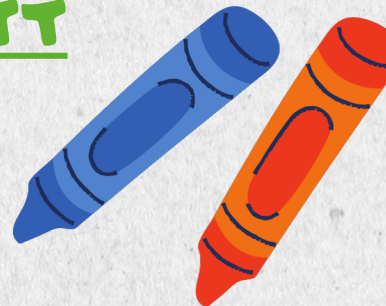

This session will be for our current PreK students only. Parents are asked to come and fill out or drop off completed paperwork. At the end of the session our PreK students will return to Ms. Kalyn and finish the school day.

- Parents and children will arrive at the beginning of the session.
- Children will spend the session in the classroom.
- Parents of the morning session, once all paperwork and online forms are complete you will be free to go.
- Parents will receive and/or turn in registration paperwork, our staff will be available to assist. Children's Scholarship Fund and OSN online registration will happen at this time.
- Current All Saints PK families, all paperwork will be sent home prior to Roundup, if you complete it and turn it into the office you do not need to attend the session.


