



#### Requirements?

- The applicant must meet the requirements to be a recipient of a CSF scholarship
- She must spend a day at Marian (Visit Day) during her seventh-grade year or the fall semester of her eighth-grade year.
- She must take the 8th-grade placement exam at Marian on **Saturday, January 13th, 2024** and meet admission requirements.
- By January 31st she must submit the following; a letter of recommendation from a current teacher/principal, an essay about what it would mean for her to attend Marian, and a personal statement that reflects her family story.
